PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES UPDATES
IN VIEW OF DORSCON LEVEL: ORANGE

Precautionary Measure

In line with the Ministry of Health's advisory and guidelines, please do not attend church services or activities if:

- **a) You and / or your children have recently returned from mainland China, had close contact with a recent traveller to mainland China or come in contact with any suspected / confirmed cases of the Novel Coronavirus.** Please do not attend church services or connect group meetings for 14 days, starting from the day of your return / contact.

Note:

- - If the person you came into contact with has no flu-like symptoms after 14 days since their return, it will be deemed safe for you to attend church services and activities.
- - If however, the person you came into contact with has flu-like symptoms, you may only attend church services and activities 14 days after the date of contact
- **b) You and / or your children should feel unwell or experience any flu-like symptoms (fever, sore throat, cough, runny nose and shortness of breath).** Please seek medical attention immediately and take time to rest and fully recuperate at home.

Stepped-up measures (to be implemented with immediate effect)

- Institution of **CENTRALIZED** temperature-screening at Church Foyer
 - Temperature & Health Declaration
 - Collection of Contact details of all persons who walks into church for Contact tracing purposes
 - If your temperature is found to be higher than 37.5 degrees Celsius, you will be asked to go home and rest, and seek medical attention
- **NO** parking on premises for the set up of Temperature Screening points;
Drop off for wheelchair, elderlies only
 - You are encouraged to park at the surrounding blocks and walk in
- **Designated routes and access points for the various services** has been designed for containment purposes
 - Specific directions will be given to you at the main gate (To be strictly adhered to for your well-being)

Designated Routes & Access Points

- Stick to the same designated route for both entry & exit

- English Congregation:
 - Temperature taking at Church foyer
 - Adults with Children to proceed to Lift 2 for access to KidsConnect on Level 2 then to sanctuary
 - Parents with Children are advised to be seated on the extreme right of the sanctuary facing the stage
 - All other adults to access sanctuary via Lift 1/Centre Staircase
 - Designated toilets for adults are on Level 2
 - Female toilet beside Lift 1 only
 - Male toilet beside Joshua Room
- KidsConnect (Toddlers, Kindies & Primary School):
 - Temperature taking at Church foyer
 - Children to proceed with parents to Lift 2 for access to KidsConnect on Level 2
 - Check in on Level 2 at Daniel Hall entrance outside Lift 2
 - Female Toilet beside Classroom 5 will be converted for Children's use only

Designated Routes & Access Points

- Stick to the same designated route for both entry & exit

- Youth Service:

- Temperature taking at Church foyer
- Youths attending English Service to access Level 4 Youth Hall via Staircase beside Lift 2 only
- Youths attending Youth Service only to access Level 4 Youth Hall via Lift 2 from 12:30pm onwards
- Designated toilets are on Level 4

- Filipino Service:

- Temperature taking at Church foyer
- Filipinos attending English Service to access Level 2 Caleb Room via Lift 1/Center Staircase only
- Filipinos attending Filipino Service only to access Level 2 Caleb Room via Lift 1/Center Staircase only
- Designated toilets for adults are on Level 2
 - Female toilet beside Lift 1 only
 - Male toilet beside Joshua Room

Designated Routes & Access Points

- Stick to the same designated route for both entry & exit

- Indian Service (Saturday):
 - Temperature taking at Church foyer
 - Those attending Indian Service only to access Level 2 Caleb Room via Lift 1/Center Staircase only
 - Designated toilets for adults are on Level 2
 - Female toilet beside Lift 1 only
 - Male toilet beside Joshua Room
- Chinese Congregation:
 - Temperature taking at the vending machine area
 - Direct access into chapel via side entrance beside Level 1 Male toilet
 - Designated toilets for adults are on Level 1 outside chapel only
- Dialect Congregation:
 - Temperature taking at Church foyer
 - Proceed directly to Gideon Hall
 - Designated toilets within Gideon Hall only

Designated Routes & Access Points

- Stick to the same designated route for both entry & exit
- Chinese Congregation (Saturday):
 - Temperature taking at the Church foyer
 - Direct access into chapel via side entrance beside Level 1 Male toilet
 - Designated toilets for adults are on Level 1 outside chapel only
- Chinese Childrens' Ministry (Saturday):
 - Temperature taking at Church foyer
 - Children to proceed with parents to Lift 2 for access to Daniel Hall on Level 2
 - Check in on Level 2 at Daniel Hall entrance outside Lift 2
 - Female Toilet beside Classroom 5 will be converted for Children's use only

Enhanced Safety Measures for Services

- **Only** the following services will be continued in this period:
 - English Main Service & Children Services (Sunday, 9:30-11:30am)
 - Chinese Services (Saturday, 7:30-10pm & Sunday, 10:30-12:30pm)
 - Cantonese Service (Saturday, 4-6pm)
 - Hokkien Service (Sunday, 9:30-11:30am)
 - Youth Service (Sunday, 1:30-3:30pm)
 - Filipino Service (Sunday, 12:00-2:00pm)
 - Indian Service (Saturday, 7:30-10pm)
- There will be **NO** bible study classes, discipleship classes, oikos, P&P, tuition centre, and other meetings until further notice
- Please note that there will be **NO refreshments** after service until further notice (This is to discourage mass gatherings, you are encourage to proceed in small groups to fellowship over lunch outside)

Enhanced Safety Measures for Premises

- Regular disinfecting of church premises
- Provision of Hand Sanitisers at Worship Halls
- Points of frequent contact, such as elevator buttons and door handles, equipment will be sterilised often
